We recommend that you eat on Thursday night at Wilfs in the Community Hall, where you will also register for the event, collect tee shirts, listen to some music and be able to enjoy a fine pint of Skye Ale (raising money for MRT) with your friends.

Options for Saturday night if you haven't pre-booked a meal or you are still hungry afterwards

Community Hall – 300 Main Course Meals - 18:00 – 22:00 [All Tickets Now Sold]

These meals are all suitable for those with Coeliac Disease and will include 150 Beef Stew & Potatoes, 100 Chicken Curry/Rice and 50 Veg Curry/Rice (suitable for Vegans). There will also be a bar serving 18 casks of Skye Ales from across the water at Uig - Gold, Red and Lager at £3 a pint. **100%** of proceeds go to Arrochar and Hebrides Mountain Rescue.

• Island Bites Van Above The Village Car Park From 09:00 – 21:30

Island Bites is located 50M from the Community Hall and they like to serve fresh produce prepared on site from various burgers to hot ciabatta sandwiches. Our most popular dishes are our curry and fresh battered haddock. Our prices are competitive ranging from **£5.50** for the burgers and chips to **£7.50** for our fish and chips.

• AD's Takeaway From 17:00 – 21:30

Recently re-opened and will serve fish and chips for £7.50.

• Hotel Hebrides

The hotel is beside the Community Hall. It has 2 areas serving food within the Hotel, firstly the Mote Bar which serves a range of pub style food including pizzas, burgers, fish and chips, steak, macaroni cheese, plus daily specials. Tables in the bar cannot be reserved and are first come, first served. They also serve takeaway food from the bar (fish and chips, burgers and pizza) however the number of takeaways they are able to sell will be limited as the kitchen will prioritise sit in guests. They also have the Pierhouse Restaurant, an AA Rosette restaurant which specialises in local seafood. The menu changes daily and an average spend for 3 courses is about £35-40 per person, plus drinks. Advanced booking is essential in the Pierhouse Restaurant **01859 502364.**

Horgabost Campsite – 11 Miles South of Tarbert on Seaward Side of A859

Richard and Lena will keep the food trailer open at Horgabost on Saturday the 2nd June. Blas bhon lar will be open from 6pm to 8pm at Horgabost campsite. As well as some of their usual menu which includes vegetarian options and gluten free options, they will have a casserole of some description and vegetarian chilli available. The price for most of the meals whether on their usual menu or their casserole and chilli dishes will be in the region of **£8** per head.
